## Overview

The **USAID Climate Ready BOSS Project** strengthens the adaptation and mitigation ability of national governments and regional organizations in the Pacific Islands by mobilizing climate finance and improving climate finance management.

## Goal

- Strengthened capacity of Pacific Island Countries to adapt and respond to climate and disaster impacts.

## Objectives

- Mobilize climate finance from public and private sources.
- Improve climate finance management through institutional strengthening and enhancing the enabling environment.
- Effective and streamlined coordination of climate finance through various partners and access modalities.
- Inclusive and equitable participation of indigenous communities and those most impacted by climate change, including women and children.

### Timeframe:

- August 2024 - August 2029

### Total Funding:

- USD 43.34 Million

### Main Expected Results

- USD 1.05 Billion in climate finance mobilized
- 50,000 people with increased resilience
- 5,000 people trained in climate change adaptation
- 165 institutions with improved capacity to address climate change
- 65 policies and strategies developed
- Strengthened inclusion, equity and coordination of climate finance
